

CWYSC Player Evaluation Process

- All players wishing to play on a Travel 1 or Travel 2 team must attend player evaluations. It is recommended that players attend all evaluations sessions for their age group.
- Players not attending will be placed on a Travel 3 team, or the lowest Travel team for that age group.
- If a player is not able to attend any of their respective evaluation dates due to illness, injury or other extenuating circumstance, parents should contact the Commissioner for that age group as soon as possible PRIOR TO THE FIRST EVALUATION FOR THEIR CHILDS AGE GROUP. Under these circumstances, the Coaching Committee will confer with current and past coaches to determine what level the player should be placed.
- A minimum of 3 evaluators will be present at all evaluations.
- Evaluators will consist of 2 Coaching Committee members and the Head Coaches from the Spring Season for each age group. In the event that there are not enough Head Coaches at an age group, Assistant Coaches will be used.
- Evaluations will be based on several criteria using a scoring system for each category. All evaluator's scores will be totaled and then averaged to determine the players score.
- The Coaching Committee will provide the Evaluation syllabus.
- Players will be evaluated on technical ability (passing, dribbling, shooting, etc.), fitness (speed, strength, endurance, etc.), knowledge of the game (proper positioning, rules of the game, etc.) and attitude, sportsmanship and commitment.
- After evaluations are complete for all age groups, a list sorted by score will be presented to the Head Coach.
- Head Coaches will select players from this list. U10 Coaches are allowed 2 Add/Drops, U11 and up are allowed 3 Add/Drops. Any Add/Drops that are made must be discussed with the Coaching Committee prior to final roster selection.
- Roster size will be determined by the Coaching Committee based on registered players.
- Any players that wish to play up an age level must notify the evaluators when arriving at each session. It is STRONGLY recommended that all players wishing to play up also attend their proper age groups evaluation. A player must score well enough to be considered for the top travel team to play up.
- Players who wish to stay with their grade level need only attend that age groups evaluation session.
- CWYSC understands that certain circumstances may occur that are not covered under these guidelines and will review any issues that may arise on a case-by-case basis.
- If a player, Parent or Guardian feels that these guidelines were not followed, and as a result a player was not treated fairly, they should contact the respective Commissioner or Board Member.
